## PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT.



LTYC's Executive Director, Dana Carr along with the Director of Program's & Partnerships, Aisha Austin facilitated a professional development training titled "*Culturally Responsive Teaching Through The Arts*" in partnership with the Montgomery County Collaboration Council for Children, Youth & Families on April 10, 2018.

Through hands on and student-centered instruction, participants were asked to dig deep and speak truths about their own privilege, media's constructions of race, gender, culture etc. and the impact it has on their instruction. Using the World Cafe model as a foundation, participants examined various art forms including dance, theatre, music and visual arts that forced them to ask tough questions, reflect and find solutions and strategies that were culturally competent for immediate implementation through the arts.
