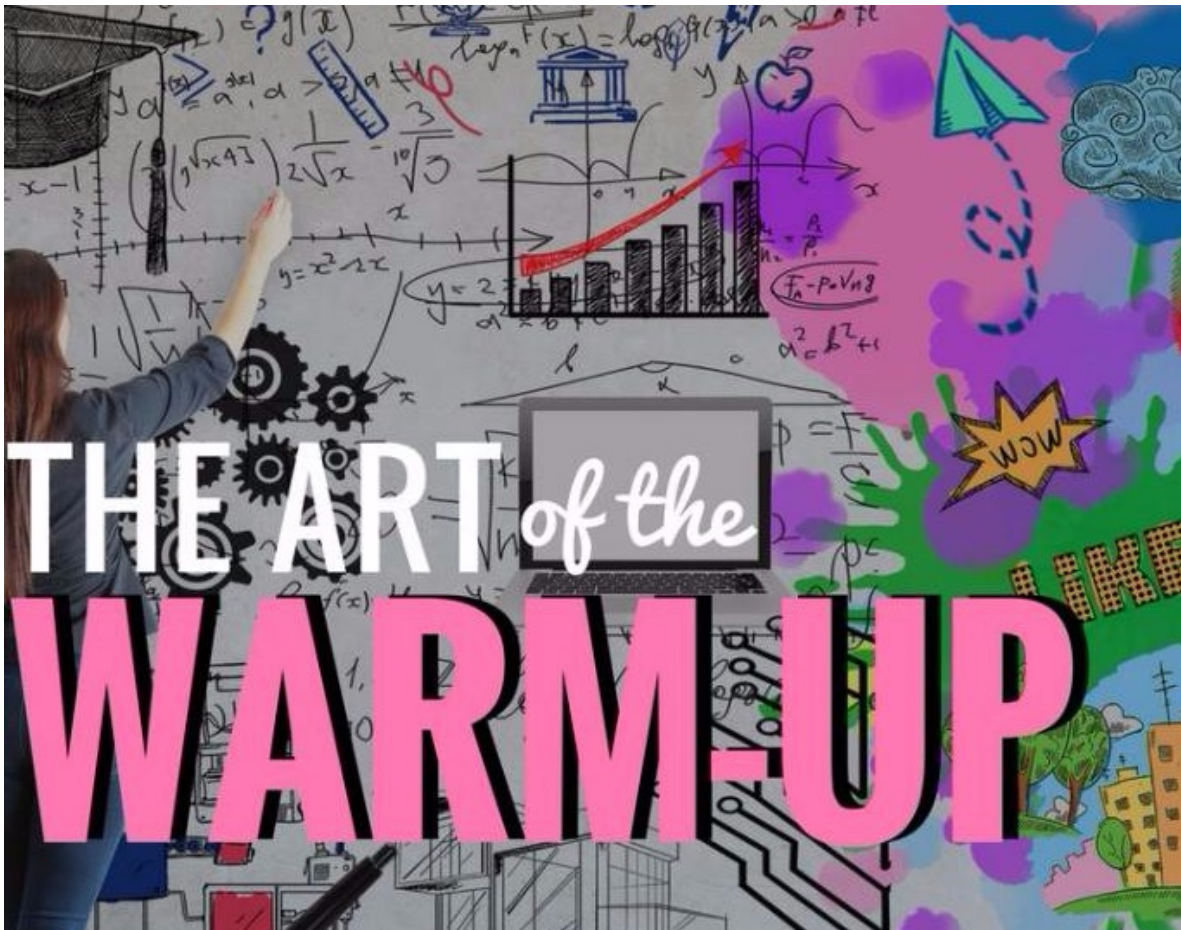


Civic Works
